### Who May Apply

All teachers and service providers (OT/PT/SLP, etc) of Columbia Public School District who work with students with an IEP or 504, and are members of SEPTA, are eligible to apply for mini-grants under this program. Teachers and staff may apply individually or collaboratively. ### When to Apply

Mini-Grant applications will be accepted throughout the year. Mini-grants will be awarded on the final day of each month for the remainder of the 2018-19 school year

### Purpose of the Mini-Grant

The purpose of the mini-grant is to provide funding to enrich, enhance or assist the education, inclusion or well-being of students receiving special education services or with special needs. In addition, the mini-grants are to support teachers and staff in their creative and innovative thinking.

### Grant Funding

The grant program is made possible by the fundraising efforts of the Columbia Special Education PTA. Currently, the mini-grant amounts will be up to \$100.

### Grant Committee

The Grant Committee is composed of at least the SEPTA Vice-President, the SEPTA Treasurer, and at least two parent members of SEPTA.

Grant recipients will be supplied with the PTA's tax ID number so that sales tax will not be applied to the purchase.
